- You will be able to print out a certificate of completion at the end of each program.

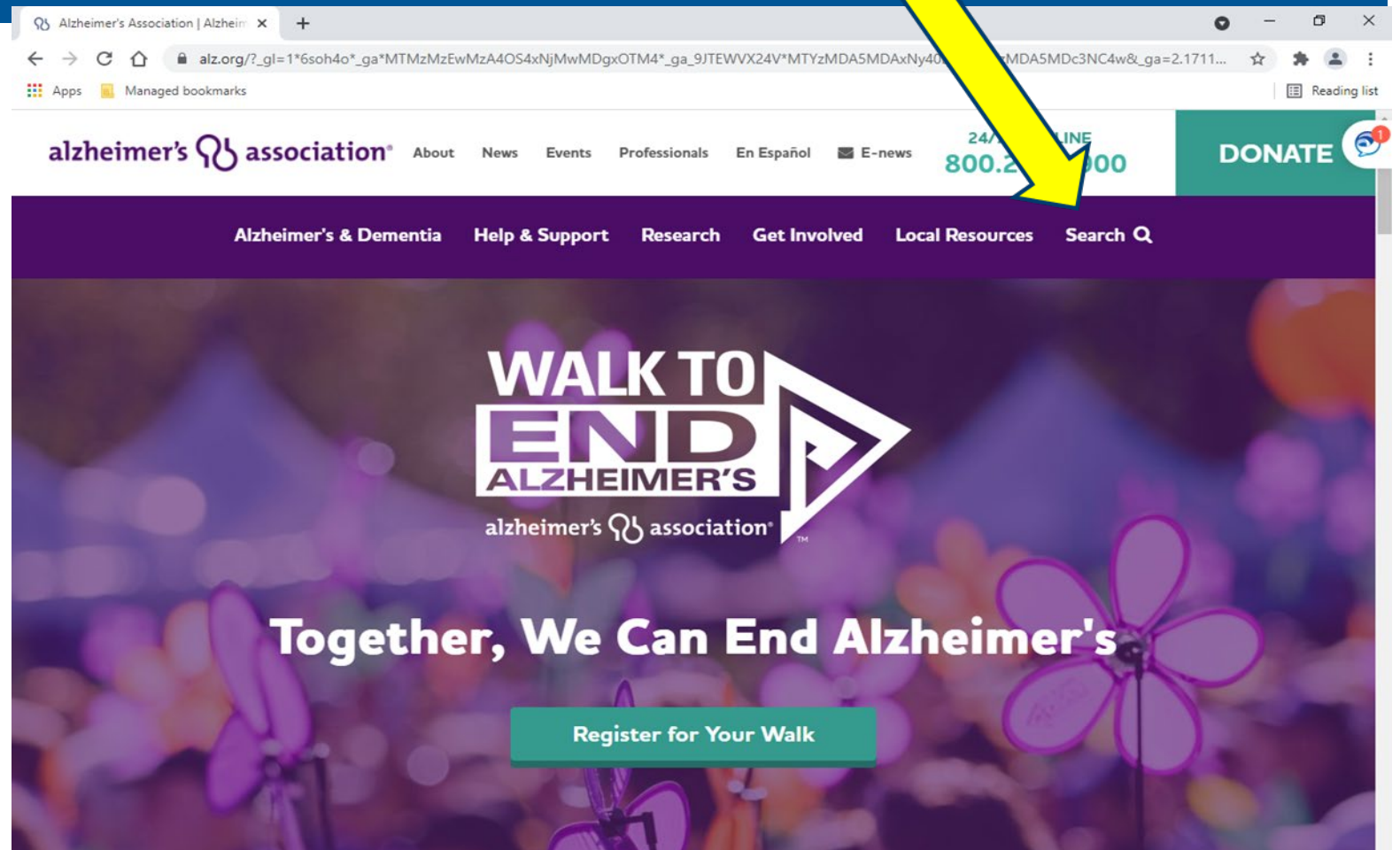

- Picture to the right is what your screen should look like




